Sandeep Lamichhane, Sita Rana Magar, Rohit Kumar Paudel and Karan K.C. for the Cricketer of the Year (Men's and Women's), Emerging Cricketer of the Year and Moment of the Year, respectively. Likewise, Lifetime Achievement Award was also awarded to Komal Bahadur Pandey for his contribution in Nepalese cricket.
